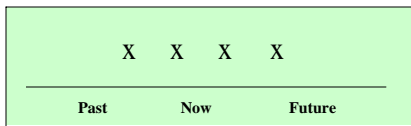

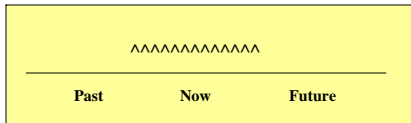

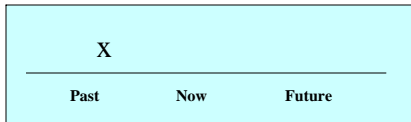
B. Look at the time-lines below and the sentences that go with them.



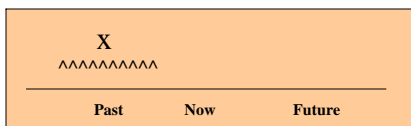
I work every day



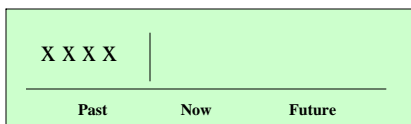
I'm working now as usual



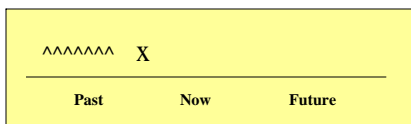
I started work at 8 o'clock yesterday morning



I was working in the morning when you came into the office

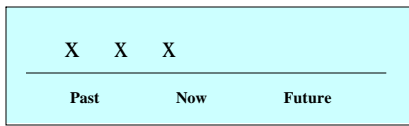

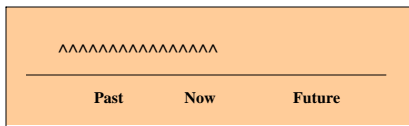


In fact, I had been working for an hour by the time you arrived

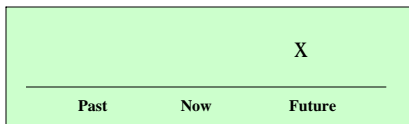

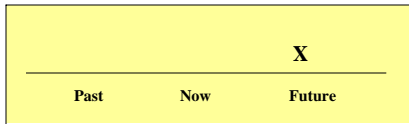

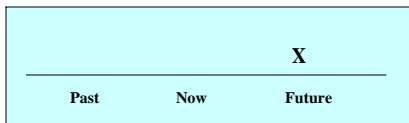
I've been working here for 10 months now



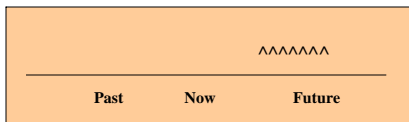
I hope I will finish at 5 o'clock today



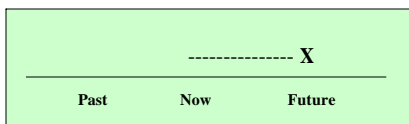
I'm going to work really hard so that I can finish on time



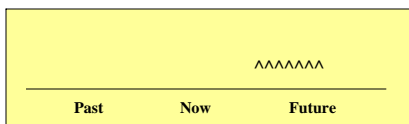
I'm working tomorrow, of course
